

Welcome to Malmö



This is a quick guide over some things to do and see in Malmö. You are very welcome to ask people in the racing office for more information and hints.

Museums:

Malmöhus castle - built in 1526-1530, now an art, nature and historic museum.
Open daily 10-16
Entrance fee: Adults 40 SEK, children 7-15 years 10 SEK younger free
Entrance to the Science and Maritime museum included if visited the same day.
Address: Malmöhusvägen 6



Rundan sightseeing - Go through the canals, under bridges and see Malmö from a different perspective. With personal guide you get a vivid tour of the history, personalities, buildings and anecdotes.
Departure daily every hour between 10.30 and 18.30. The tour takes 50 minutes.
Fee: Adults 110 SEK, children 6-11 years 55 SEK, younger free
Departure from Norra Vallgatan, opposite the Central station

Malmö panorama - Join on a sightseeing tour through the central parts of Malmö on a sightseeing bus. It takes you to famous places and buildings that Malmöhus Castle, Limhamns limestone quarry and the Turning Torso.
Departure daily 11.00 - 13.00 - 15.00 The tour takes 1 h 15 mins.
Fee: Adults 110 SEK, children 6-11 years 55 SEK, younger free
Departure from Norra Vallgatan, opposite the Central station



The Terrarium - an exhibition with reptiles, spiders, kangaroos and other exotic animals.
Open Mo-Fr 10-19 Sa-Su 12-19
Entrance fee: Adults 70 SEK children 7-14 years 40 SEK younger free
Address: Amiralsgatan, Malmö Folkets park (Peoples park in Malmö)

Turning Torso - Guided tour on 54th floor with a fantastic view over Malmö with surroundings and Copenhagen. **Take the opportunity to see the J24 fleet from above.**

Entrance fee: Adults 195 SEK, children 125 SEK

Bathing and golf:

Ribersborgs beach - Sandbeach with several piers, **perfect view over the sailing area.**
Entrance free.



Scaniabadet - a bit north of Western harbor - deep see swimming, from piers, next to the bath is a small serving of refreshments. Entrance free.



Ribban green golf - Miniature golf course on Ribersborg. Open daily 10-22 (in case of rain it might be closed). Adults 60 SEK, children up to 12 40 SEK, club and ball included.

Train to Copenhagen center departs every 20 minutes from Central station in Malmö.
The Malmö Festival opens Friday the 20th, with music scenes and food servings in whole town center.

Supermarkets and food

In Western harbor is ICA MAXI. In Limhamn center you find ICA and Willys, good supermarkets, in walking distance from the marina. Lidl is situated on Hyllie kyrkoväg 45A, also on walking distance.



Fiskehoddorna - Fiskehoddorna Malmö is the region's largest marketplace for fresh fish and shellfish. Situated in a unique setting in the middle of Malmö city center, with a wide range of what the ocean has to offer, caught by local fishermen and we sell shellfish from the West Coast as well.

Limhamns Fiskrökeri - Every day they have smoked fish, freshly cooked seafood, own pickled herring and other good things that they cook. Store for take away and restaurant.
